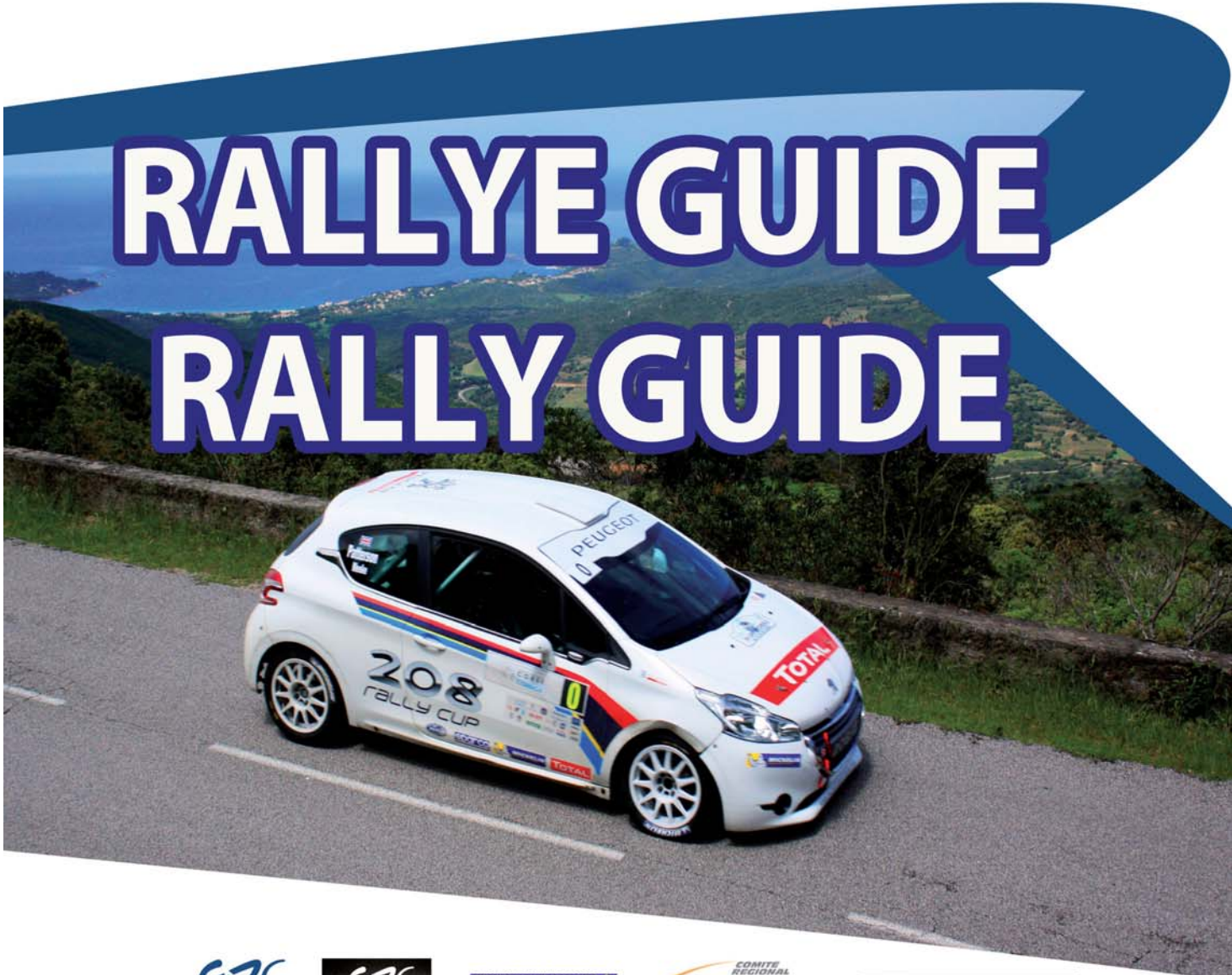

Welcome to the 57<sup>th</sup> ASACC Tour de Corse!

Following Tour de Corse's return in 2011 as part of the Intercontinental Rally Challenge, last season's event was run as a hugely successful French European Rally Championship round.

The stunning Corsican backdrop was perfectly captured by series promoter Eurosport, emphasising the spirit of *Île de Beauté* (the 'Isle of Beauty').

The event – known as the '1000-corner rally' – proved as challenging as ever in 2013, with the winner claiming victory on the final stage. Its popularity was highlighted 12 months ago by the 60-strong entry list that provided a blend of professional and amateur competitors.

The 57<sup>th</sup> edition returns as France's ERC round, and will cover all of Southern Corsica. It will also revert to its traditional autumnal date for which it's most famous.

Tour de Corse will kick-off in Porto-Vecchio on Friday 7 November, with drivers heading towards Propriano and Ajaccio later that evening for a total of six stages throughout the opening day.

Every competitor will twice tackle a special three-stage loop when they leave Ajaccio on Saturday morning, before returning to the heart of Ajaccio for the event's final challenge at 'Place du Diamant'.

With Eurosport also electing to stage Tour de Corse as 2014's season finale, it will benefit from guaranteed media coverage throughout.

This will be of particular importance to home-grown talents who are looking to make a name for themselves. Indeed, Corsican amateur drivers will compete for a special trophy on the event's second stage that also allows them to battle with their professional counterparts.

Finally, I would like to offer my best wishes to all the competitors, officials and volunteers participating in this year's Tour de Corse.

May the 57<sup>th</sup> running of the '1000-corner rally' continue the event's success and provide us with another thrilling spectacle.

### 4.2 - Entry procedure

Anyone wishing to take part in the **57<sup>th</sup> Tour de Corse Automobile** must send the official entry form duly completed to the Secretary of the organisation at the head office (contact details in Art. 2.3) before the entry closing date (postmarked on or before the closing date). **If this entry form is sent by fax or e-mail, the original version must reach the organiser within five days following the close of entries.**

**Entries will only be accepted if they include the following:**

- the entry fee in full,
- an authorisation issued by the competitor's and Pilots' National Sporting Authority,
- a photocopy of the first page of filled technical card,
- a photocopy of the entrant's international licence,
- photocopies of the two crew members international competition licences,
- photocopies of the two crew members driving licences,
- a letter of authorisation from the owner for the use of his car in the event (if applicable),
- a photocopy of the car's technical passport (for French competitors),
- a photocopy of the car's registration document,
- Recce car registration,
- Medical Card.

Details concerning the co-driver can be completed at the administrative checks.

During the rally, service will be made into the Service Parks (Porto-Vecchio & Ajaccio). **Servicing outside these zones is forbidden.**

According to FIA-RRSR Art. 48, 49 & 50 (Art. 51 & 52 will not apply)

Only two service vehicles and one auxiliary car per competitor will be authorised in the Service Parks. **These vehicles must have the «ASSISTANCE» or «AUXILIAIRE» stickers affixed on the windscreen.** They must imperatively be parked in the allocated surface of each competitor. Any breach of this rule will be fined with € 500 TTC.

**Crews wishing to have their service areas side by side should indicate it at the moment of their inscription.**

### Allocated surfaces in Service Parks :

**ERC Registered Team :** 200 m<sup>2</sup>

**Team Supported Entry / Other Legal Entity / FIA Priority Entry :**

140 m<sup>2</sup> for one entered car

200 m<sup>2</sup> for two cars

50 m<sup>2</sup> for each additional car.

**Amateur Entry:** 80 m<sup>2</sup> per entered car.

Additional space can be ordered before the closing date of entries. It will be allocated as opportunities and ERC terms of reference, and charged at the rate of € 12 per m<sup>2</sup>

### Cleanliness and safety of your stand

**Each competitor is responsible** for the behavior of its service team members.

In the service park, all competitors must :

- keep near to any racing car **a fire extinguisher for A, B and C type fires of a minimum capacity of 5 kg**, having been checked within the last 2 years.

- place under each racing car **a waterproof and resistant to hydrocarbons ground sheet** of a surface equal to that of the car (3m x 5m minimum).

- **take care of his waste removal** when his team leaves the parks at the latest; failure to comply will result in a cash penalty of € 500 (vat incl.).

**The penalty for extinguisher or ground sheet failure in the parks is € 200 TTC each (vat incl.).**

**Waste water emptying, car wash and the driving of stakes into the ground are forbidden in the Service Parks.**

## **7 - FUEL / TYRES**

### **7.1 - FUEL**

Only Fuel approved by Annexe J 2014 – Article 282.9

There will be no unique imposed fuel supplier.

For information, **only unleaded 95 fuel is available in commercial filling stations in Corsica (no unleaded 98 fuel).**

### **Car using SP98 ron fuel:**

Organisers will give on the website of rally: [www.asacc.fr](http://www.asacc.fr) an purchase order for SP98 FUEL.

Please return this document with entry form.

Dead-line: 20 October 2014, when the entries closed.

### **Distribution during the rally**

Competitors may only refuel in the designated refueling zones (RZ) or at commercial filling stations on the rally route and specified in the Road-Book.

In these areas any kind of servicing is prohibited except the refueling of the car.

### **Refueling Zones (RZ) :**

The refueling must be made by the crew or by members of the team (2 persons maximum) (see FIA-RRSR Art. 58.2.7).

In this last case, it is recommended that these persons are wearing complete fire-resistant approved (FIA-RRSR Art. 58.2.3), overalls, if not, it's compulsory for them to wear clothes covering arms and legs (no shorts or T-shirts).

## **7.2 - TYRES**

### **7.1 - Tyres specified for use during the rally**

.As well as adhering to the 2014 Sports regulation of regional rallies, the amount of tyres for use are shown in the chart below.

#### **7.1.1 - Eligible tyres for the registered ERC Junior Championship Competitors**

##### **Juniors ERC Tyres**

**Details about the tyre specifications for ERC Junior Championship competitors as well as the tyre lottery schedule will be published in a later date by Bulletin.**

It is forbidden to change tyres between service parks unless they are the spare tyres already in the car. This change has to be done by the driver and/or the co-driver.

Only marked tyres may be used during the rally.

Tyre marking will be carried out as indicated in the Road-Book.

The use of an anti puncture device (ATS or other) is prohibited.

Hand Cutting

The intentional modification of the design of the tyre or the number of studs on the tyres on or in the car is strictly **forbidden**.

Vehicles from the European Union do not need specific documents for customs clearance. Only non-EU competitors will need to show an ATA (obtainable from the Board of Trade of the country of origin) to customs authorities at their point of entry into the European Union.

## 9 - HELICOPTERS

### **REGISTRATION PROCEDURE**

## 12 - RECONNAISSANCE

See FIA-RRSR Art. 25

### 12.1 - Registration Procedure

Reconnaissance documentation will be available to the competitors on Monday 03 November from 08:00 to 12:00 and 14:00 to 20:00.

All drivers will receive a specific “Reconnaissance” sticker and a reconnaissance control card.

**The sticker** must be displayed on the reconnaissance vehicle at the top & in the middle of the windscreen.

**The reconnaissance control card** must be presented to the marshal (identifiable by an official rally bib) at the start of each stage in order to gain access to the special stage. At the end of the reconnaissance tours, **the reconnaissance control card must be returned to the Administrative Checks (Cinémathèque - Porto-Vecchio) no later than Thursday 06 November at 09:00 with the crew’s driving licenses.**

## 12.2 - Specific and/or national restrictions – Speed limit on the special stages

### Programme

The reconnaissance tours will take place on Tuesday 04, November and Wednesday 05 November in accordance with schedule specified in SR - Appendix II.

Competitors will be allowed to do these in the order of their choice whilst respecting the schedule. Under no circumstances, can the special stages be run in the opposite direction to rally traffic.

All reconnaissance apart from this period is forbidden.

**A maximum of two passages** are authorized for each special stage. When a stage is used twice or more it shall be considered as one stage for the purposes of reconnaissance.

Any crew offender will not be allowed to take part in the rally.

For all crews, reconnaissance is only authorised in cars that conform to the FIA-RRSR specifications, Article 25.

It must be emphasised that the reconnaissance takes place on roads opened to everyday traffic.

**N.B As the reconnaissance runs are NOT qualifying runs, please make good note of the following:**

**- The French Highway Code must be fully respected at all times,**

**Speed limits reminder:**

**90 km /h on National roads**

**50 km /h in Urban areas- the safety and rights of other road users must be respected,**

- reconnaissance cars have to be covered by insurance as required by the law, the organisers cannot be held responsible if an accident happens on these runs.

- Any infringement of the reconnaissance regulation will be transmitted to the Stewards of the event who have the power to make all the necessary decisions including the exclusion of the competitor.

- Any competitors failure to comply with this speed limits shall result in a penalty from 25€ by km/h exceeds.

### 12.2.1 – Tracking System:

The Organiser will provide a rally-safety-tracking-system, which has to be used also during reconnaissance in the reconnaissance car. If the rally-safety-tracking-system will not be used, it is a breach of the reconnaissance regulations. The progress of the reconnaissance will be monitored via GPS system, by the french Police together with other rally officials. Evaluation of the GPS data is within the competence of Clerk of the Course. If it will be observed that the reconnaissance vehicle is not equipped with working tracking system, the crew will be penalized according to Stewards decision.

## 13 - SCRUTINEERING, SEALING AND MARKING

### 13.1 – Location and timings for the scrutineering

13.1.1 – Technical Scrutineering will be held on Wednesday 05 November from 08:00 to 16:00 in Garage Peugeot, Quartier Mazzetta, Route de Bonifacio, 20137 Porto-Vecchio, by individual notification.

All competitors will be presented for scrutineering with individual convocation and it will be informed to schedule by bulletin.

Any delay in this time will be given a penalties € 150 net for every 30 minutes of delay.

#### 13.1.2 - Markings and seal approval

According to the FIA-RRSR Article 63.3 (transmissions), FIA priority drivers and ERC priority drivers will have their spare parts limited and marked. Others drivers may have their spare parts limited and marked at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

Marking and seal approval will be made on Wednesday 05 November from 08:00 to 16:00 in Garage Peugeot, Quartier Mazzetta, Route de Bonifacio, 20137 Porto-Vecchio, by individual notification.

#### 13.1.3 - Identification

All cars must be presented for scrutiny with the rally plates, competition numbers, ERC advertising and optional advertising affixed (see SR Appendix IV). Cars which do not comply with this rule will not be fit for verification.

### 13.2 - Mud flaps

The use of mud flaps is permitted (but not compulsory) in conformity with Art. 252.7.7 of Appendix J of the FIA Sporting Code

### 13.3 - Windows

The use of silvered or tinted films is permitted in compliance with Art. 253.11 of Appendix J of the FIA Sporting Code

### 13.4 - Driver's safety equipment

All items of clothing including helmets and Hans intended to be used during the rally must be produced for scrutiny. Compliance with Appendix L Chapter III will be checked. (see SR Appendix V)..

### 13.5 - Noise level

For all cars used in a rally on French territory, the noise should be in compliance with a FIA regulations.

### 13.6 - Special National requirements

Each competing car must be equipped with a reflective triangle and two fluorescent jackets. Two belt cutters must be carried on board at all times. They must be easily accessible for the driver and co-driver when seated with their harness belt fastened (Article 253.6 Appendix J)

### 13.7 - Safety Tracking System

All cars must be fitted with a safety tracking system.

The same equipment will be used during the reconnaissance and the rally

A deposit of 200 € is required upon delivery of the equipment

Installation instructions will be provided in the Rally Guide.

The installation will be checked during Start Ceremonial, and GPS Tracking on.

For Shakedown and Free Practice, for competitors who break down during Qualifying. The car must be transported directly in the “Parc fermé” after the QS. Only when the “Parc Fermé” after QS will be opened by the stewards, the concerned competitors will be able to take their cars to the Service Park.

Any infringement will be submitted to the Stewards of the Meeting who will determine the sanction to be applied

For Qualifying Stage, Please refer to RRR ERC Art. 30.6.1 for competitors who break down during Qualifying. The car must be transported directly in the “Parc Fermé” after the QS. Only when the “Parc Fermé” after QS will be opened by the Stewards, the concerned competitors will be able to take their cars to the Service Park. For the Shakedown / Free Practice, the procedure as proposed is ok.

In this eventuality, the crews with cars have a possibility to entrance at “Parc Fermé” 1:00 before the start of the 1<sup>st</sup> Leg and after the scrutineering.

In this eventuality, restarting cars must be presented at the entry of the overnight “Parc Fermé” before one hour to start the Leg 1.

## 15 - OTHER PROCEDURES

### 15.1 – The start and finish ceremonies and starting order

#### 15.1 Start and Finish Ceremonies

The starting ceremony of the 57th Tour de Corse Automobile will take place on Thursday 06 November at 20:00, in front of the City Hall in Porto-Vecchio.

The cars will have to be parked in the “Parc Fermé”- Parking Ste Catherine at the latest 20 minutes before the beginning of the Start Ceremony.

A fine of 500€ will have to be paid on case of any delay. The crews will have to wear their overalls. All cars will leave the “Parc Fermé” in reverse order of the starting order every minute.

The cars will be parked in the “Parc Fermé” – Parking Ste Catherine - after the start ceremony.

The finishing Ceremony of the 57<sup>th</sup> Tour de Corse Automobile will take place on Saturday 08 November at 17:32 in Ajaccio.

The cars will be parked necessarily in the “Parc Fermé” located Place du Diamant after the Ceremony during one hour after the publication of the provisional classification. Only vehicles parked in the “Parc Ferme”- Place du Diamant will be officially classified.

#### 15.2 Start order and intervals

The start order and intervals shall be according to the FIA-RRSR V1 ERC Article 45.

**For 2nd Leg :** the starting order will be in reverse order of the classification at the finish of the final special stage of the previous leg, every two minutes for the FIA and ERC priority

drivers. All other competitors will start in order of the classification at the finish of the final special stage of the previous leg, every one minute.

### 15.3 - Permitted early check-in

Crews are authorised to check-in early at TC 6C and TC 11C without incurring any penalties.

### 15.4 – Control cards exchange during the rally

Control cards will be issued at the start of each stage (TC 0 & TC 6D) and changed at the start of each section (TC 3A, 6A, 9A).

### 15.5 - Special Stage start system

Special Stage starts will use an electronic, synchronised countdown system with starting lights.

This countdown system, counting down by seconds, is clearly visible to the crew from the start position.

The starting system clock displays the time on a numerical dial.

The disk is RED between starts and it becomes YELLOW 5 seconds before the ideal starting time.

5 «BEEPS» for the last 5 seconds with a high pitched “BEEP” for the start.

This system will be connected to an electronic start detection device, which is 40 cm in front of the starting line, this system records any situation should a car leave the starting line before the correct signal.



## 16 - FINISH PROCEDURE

### The rally ends at TC 11.

#### 12.5.5 - Finish Procedure

The rally ends at TC 11C.

After the podium procedure, competitors must immediately drive their cars to the final “Parc Fermé” located Place du Diamant with the exception of those drivers who have been requested to go to the technical verifications.

A pass to authorise collection of the car will be handed out to each driver at the entrance of the “Parc Fermé”. This will be declared “open” again after posting of the official final Classification and the drivers can collect their vehicles on presentation of the pass.

One hour after Posting of the final provisional Classification, the Parc Fermé will be opened to the public and the Organiser will no longer be responsible for the cars.

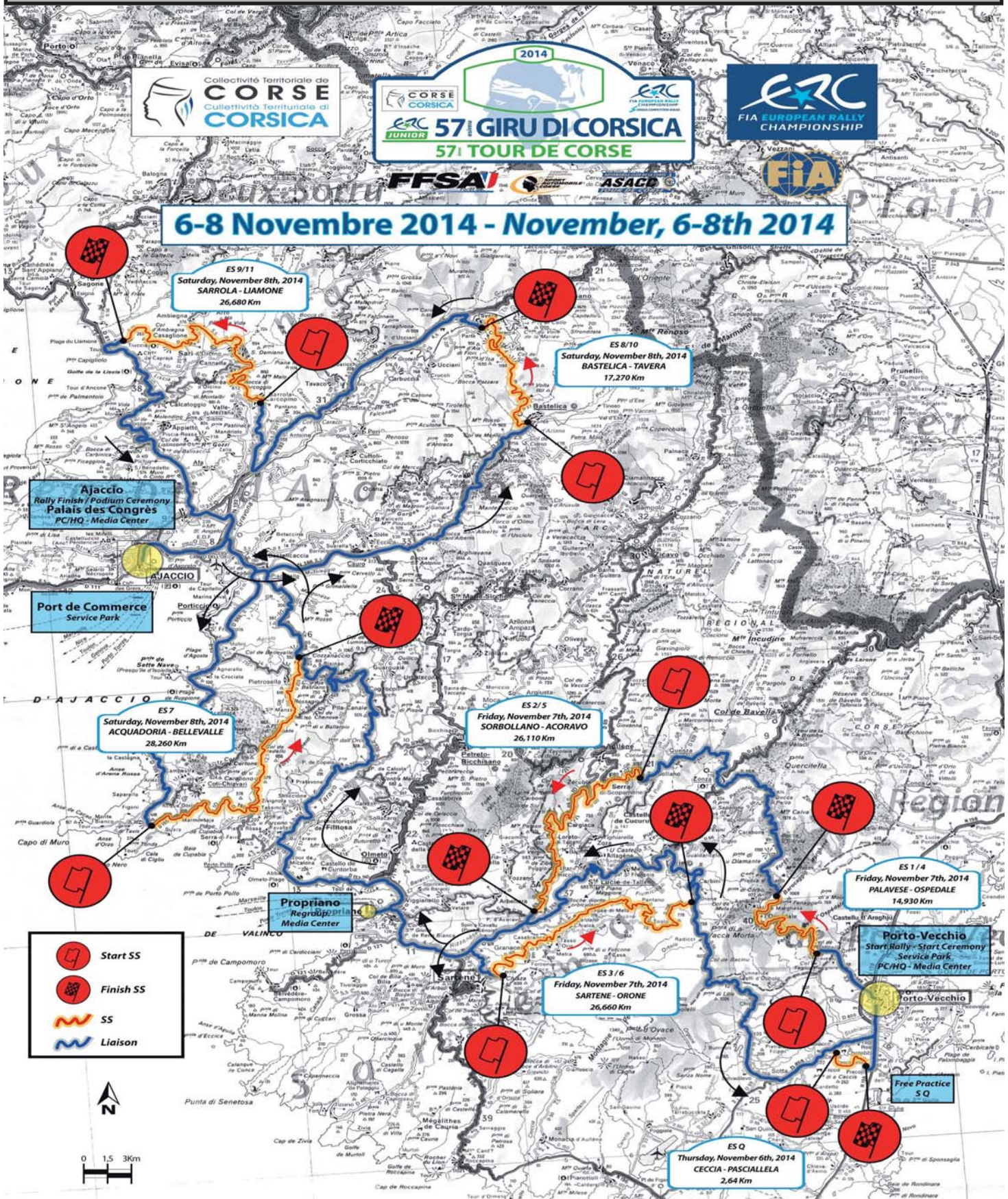

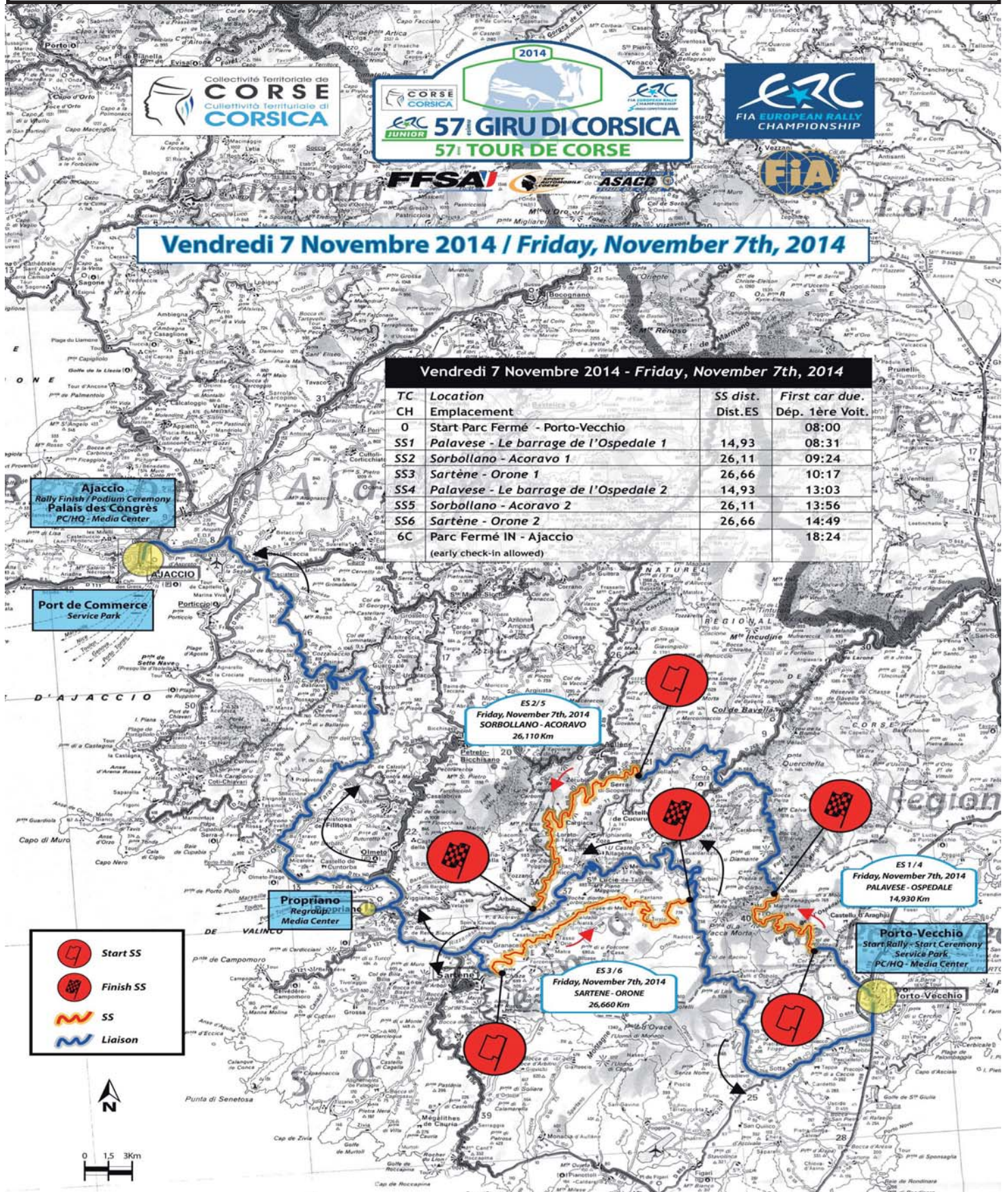

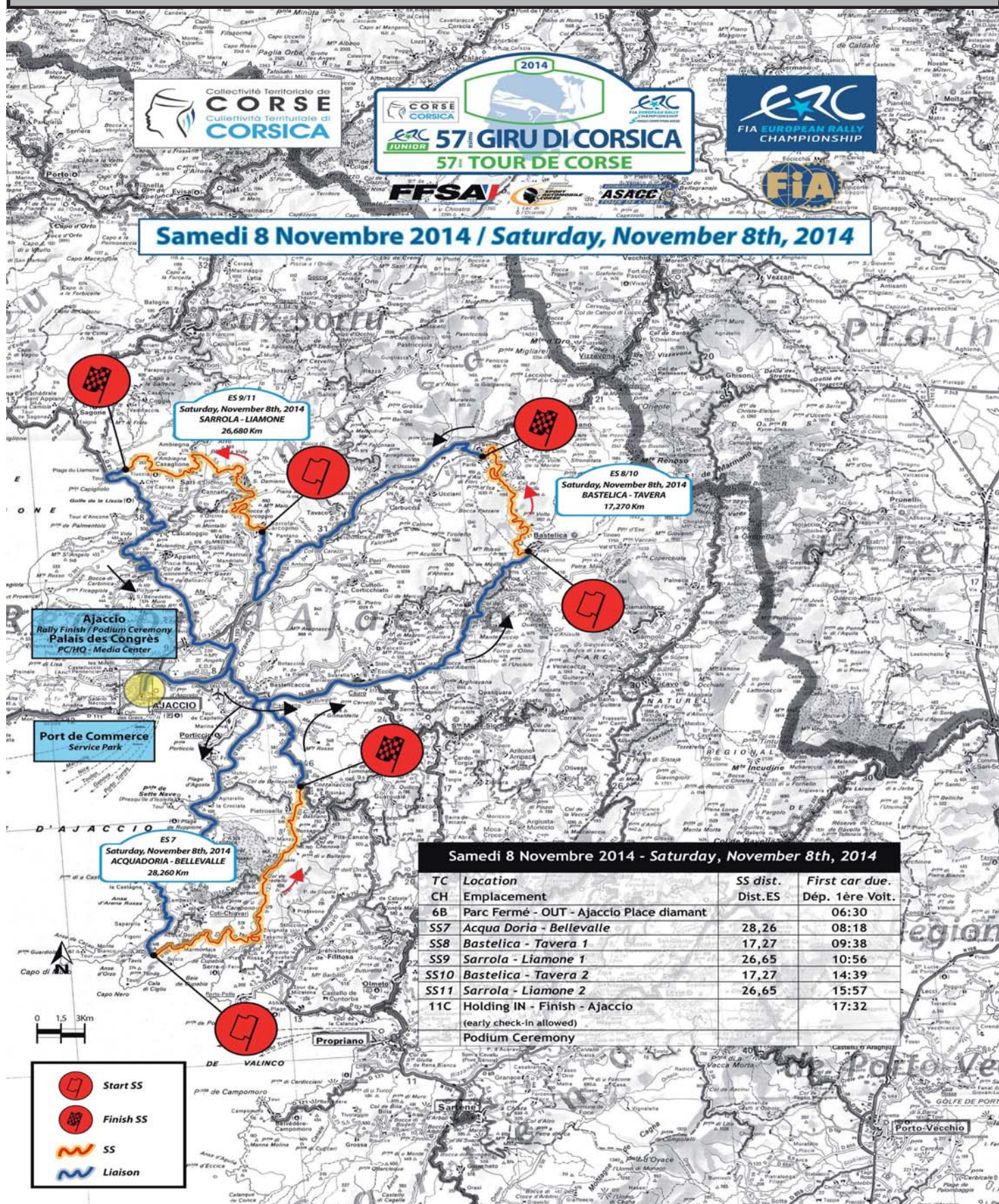

ETAPE 1 / OVERVIEW LEG 1

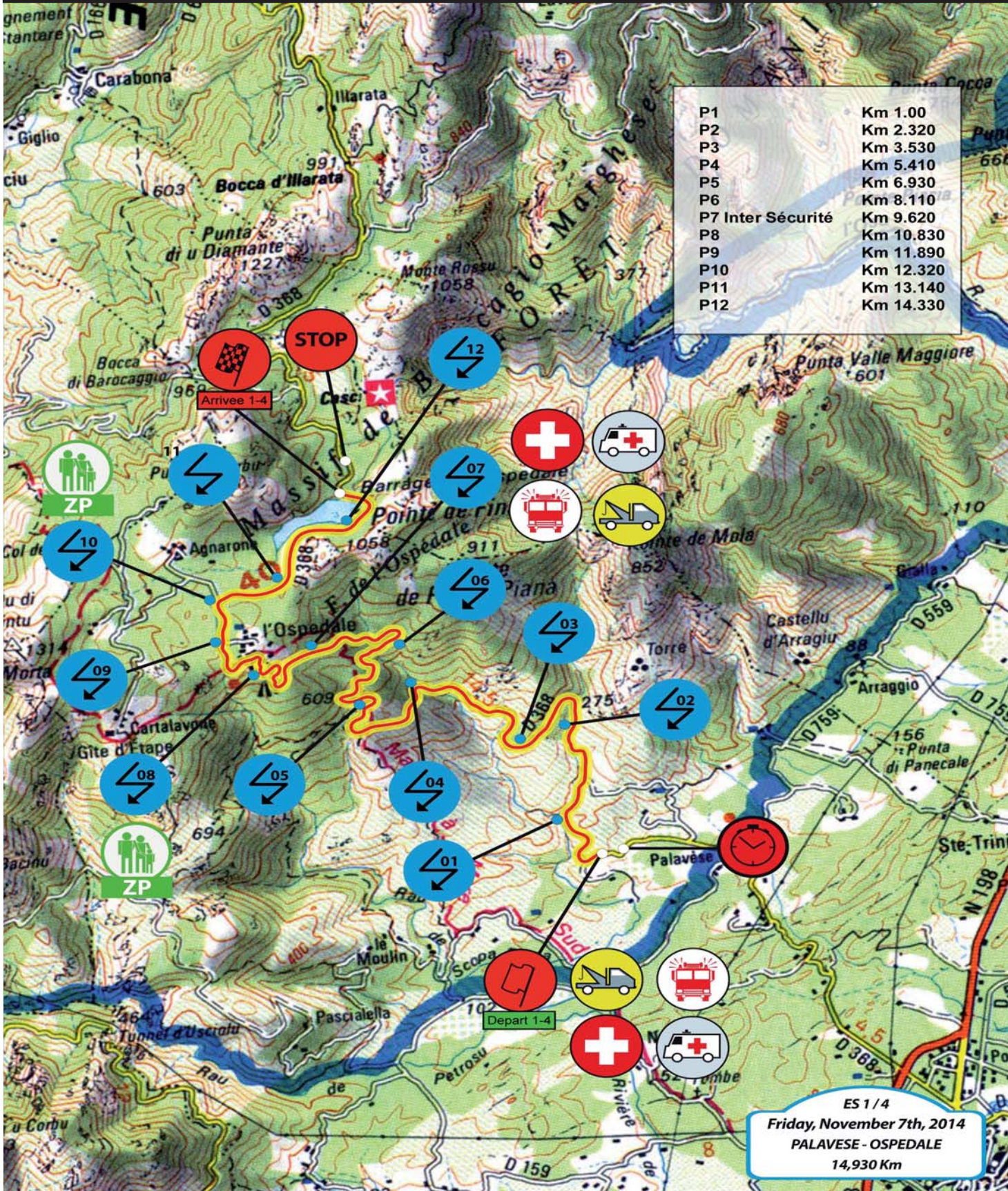

PLAN VILLE DE PORTO-VECCHIO

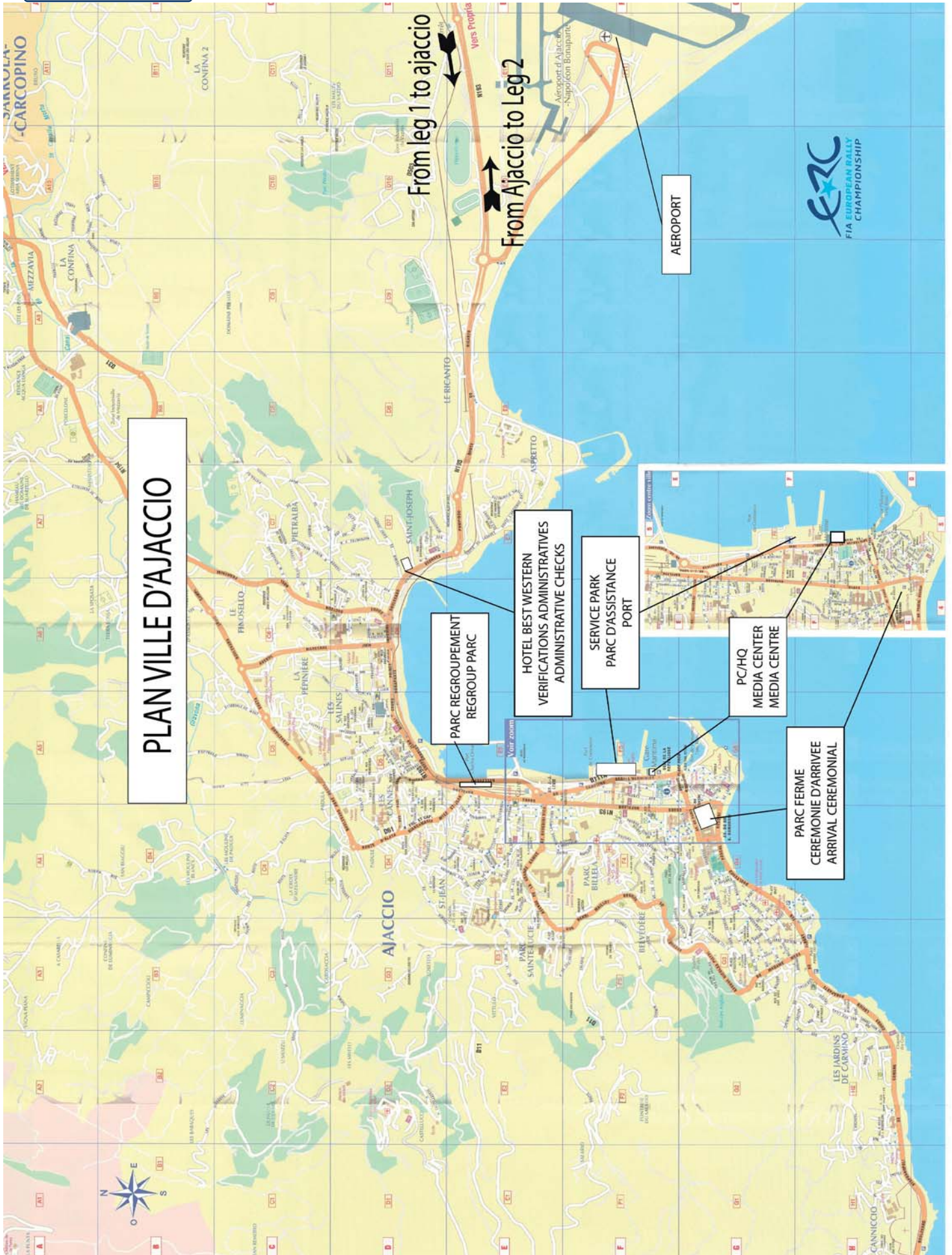


# PLAN D'ASSISTANCE - MARINA PORT PORTO-VECCHIO

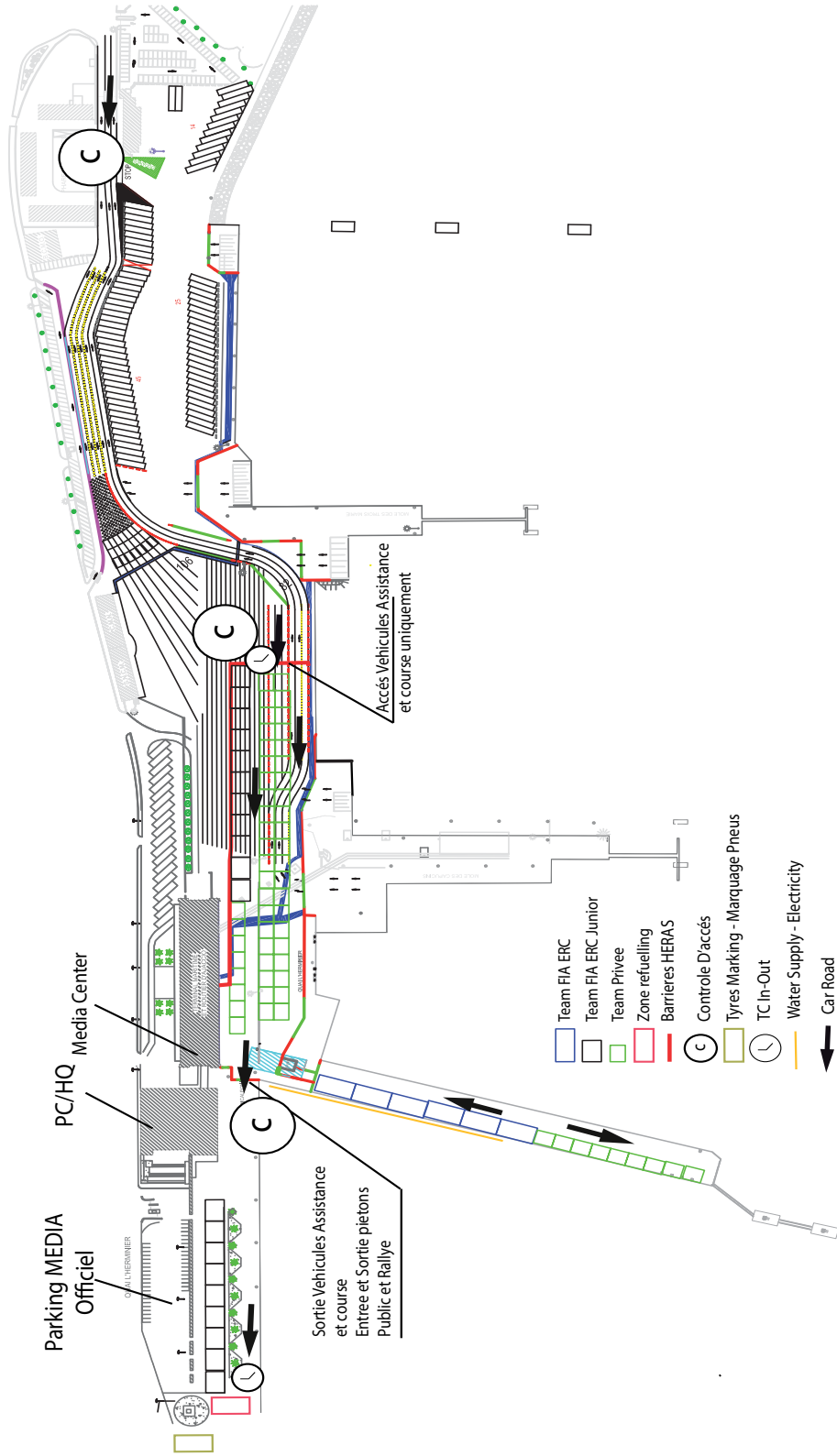


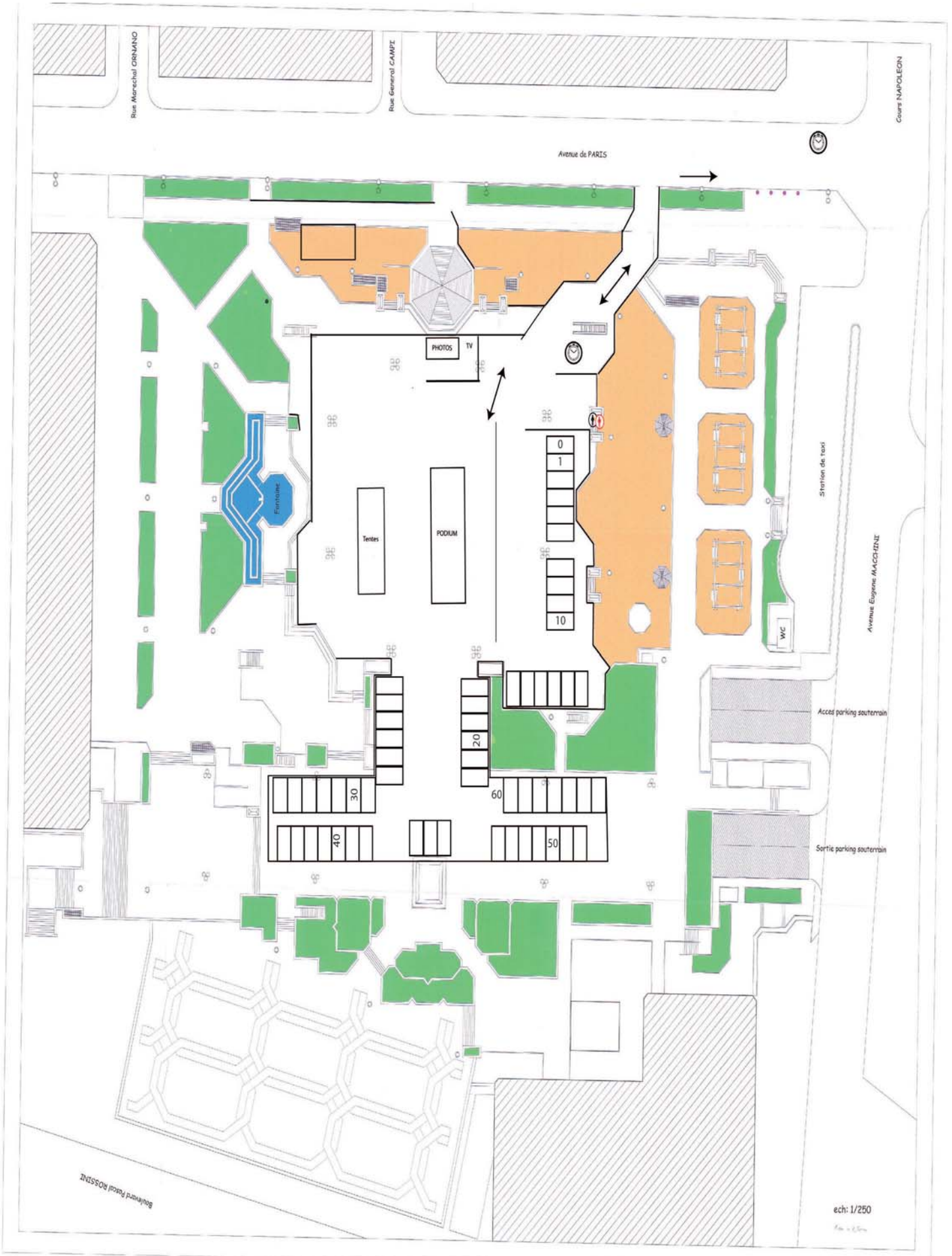
