It is forbidden to change tyres between service parks unless they are the spare tyres already in the car.

Only marked tyres may be used during the rally.

Tyre marking will be carried out as indicated in the Road-Book.

The use of an anti puncture device (ATS or other) is prohibited.

Hand cutting: the intentional modification of the design ot the tyre on or in the car is strictly forbidden.

The installation will be checked at the SP exit before the start of the Free Practice (priority drivers) or before the start of the shakedown (no priority drivers) and before the Ceremonial Start. GPS tracking has to be switched "on" during Free Practice, Qualifying Stage, and Shakedown.

Ceremonial Start:

The Ceremonial Start will take place on Thursday 06 November at 20:00 in Porto Vecchio.

The start order will be in the reverse numerical order, each minute.

The car have to check at <u>TC SP out</u> (not at Parc Fermé) <u>10mn</u> before their given scheduled time for Ceremonial Start Podium ceremony. After Ceremonial Start they have 10mn to go in Parc Fermé. A time-card will be issued at TC SP out.

Finish Ceremony:

The Finish Ceremony will take place on Saturday 08 November at 17:45 in Ajaccio.

The order for the Finish Ceremony will be:

- Cars classified 5th, 4th, 3rd, 2nd & 1st.
- Production Podium
- Junior Podium
- All others competitors in overall classification order

Delate:

The cars will be parked <u>necessarily</u> in the "Parc Fermé Final" after the ceremony, during one hour after the publication of the provisional Final Classification. <u>Only vehicles in parc fermé final appear on the final classification.</u>

All competitors must be fully conversant with FIA-RRSR Articles 39 & 40 and Appendix III § 5.5.4.2 & 5.5.4.3 Article 40 and FIA-RRSR Appendix III § 5.5.4.3, 5.5.5 & 5.6.

12.5.2 Service Park

There will be 3 2 official Service Parks: Porto Vecchio & Ajaccio (see road-book for GPS points).

12.5.3 Re-start

Modify:

Restarting cars must be presented at the entry of the overnight regroup park/parc fermé prior to leg 2 no later than 05:45 and 06:45 between 05:15 and 05:30 on Saturday 08 November.

Their re-scrutineering will take place in the overnight parc fermé between 05:45 and 06:45.

12.5.5 Finish Procedure
